A way we can all show our support to Trinity Families who foster these children is by supplying each foster child with a "blessing bag" of items they would most likely use and want. You may drop off any donations over the next two Sunday's, May 28 & June 4, in the bins located in the preschool and children's entrances. Our target age group is currently children under the age of 5.

Small Pack of Diapers (any size)

Baby Hygiene Items (diaper rash cream, petroleum jelly, gauze, q-tips, etc)

Burp Clothe and/or Bib

Baby Bottles and/or Pacifiers

Baby Bath Linens (soft washcloths and towels)

Baby Teething Items and Toys (teethers, rattles, lovey, etc)

Baby Wipes and/or Hand Sanitizer (on a string for diaper bag)

Baby Bath Items (shampoo, lotion, powder, body wash (ethnic shampoo, conditioner, and hair lotion appreciated)

Toddler and Baby Socks (boys buy for boy / girls buy for girl)

Toddler Feeding Items (bowls, spoons, forks, etc)

Sippy Cup

Baby Blankets and/or Fitted Crib Sheets

Underwear (boy and girl, any size up to 5T)

Board Books

Matchbox Cars / Small Dolls

Pajamas and Sleepers (newborn – 5T)

Hair Care (hairbrush, comb, ponytail holders, barrettes, bows, silk scarf to sleep in, silk pillowcases)

Toothbrush/Toothpaste

Preschool Bible
